General information

Based on Article 13 of the Swiss Federal Constitution and the data protection provisions of the Swiss Confederation (Data Protection Act, DSG, of September 1, 2023), every person is entitled to protection of their privacy and protection against misuse of their personal data. The operators of these pages take the protection of your personal data very seriously. We treat your personal data confidentially and in accordance with the statutory data protection regulations and this privacy policy.

In cooperation with our hosting providers, we endeavor to protect the databases as well as possible against unauthorized access, loss, misuse or falsification.

We would like to point out that data transmission over the Internet (e.g. when communicating by e-mail) may be subject to security vulnerabilities. Complete protection of data against access by third parties is not possible.

Information about the collection of personal data

In this privacy policy, we inform you about the collection of personal data when using our website. Personal data is all data that can be related to you personally, for example your name, address or e-mail address.

Collection and storage of personal data when accessing the website

If you use our website for information purposes - i.e. simply view it - we collect the personal data that your browser automatically transmits to our website server when you access it.

This information is temporarily stored in a so-called log file.

Note: Only through this data collection is it possible for the homepage to be displayed to you at all. This process is of a purely technical nature.

The following information is collected without any action on your part and stored until it is automatically deleted:

IP address of the requesting computer

Date and time of the request or access,

Time zone difference to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)

Content of the request (specific page)

Name and URL of the retrieved file

Access status/HTTP status code

Amount of data transferred in each case

Website from which the request or access was made (referrer URL)

Browser used

Your computer's operating system and its interface as well as the name of your access provider

Language and version of the browser software

We process the aforementioned data in order to display our website to you and to ensure stability and security. In particular, to ensure a smooth connection setup and convenient use of the website as well as for an evaluation of system security and system stability and for other administrative purposes.

For individual functions of our website, we require the cooperation of external service providers. We will inform you about the respective processes below in this statement.

Processing of personal data

Personal data is any information relating to an identified or identifiable person. A data subject is a person about whom personal data is processed. Processing includes any handling of personal data, regardless of the means and procedures used, in particular the storage, disclosure, procurement, deletion, storage, modification, destruction and use of personal data.

We process personal data in accordance with Swiss data protection law. In addition, we process personal data in accordance with the following legal bases in connection with Art. 6 para. 1 GDPR, insofar as the EU GDPR is applicable:

lit. a) Processing of personal data with the consent of the data subject.

lit. b) Processing of personal data for the performance of a contract with the data subject and for the implementation of corresponding pre-contractual measures.

lit. c) Processing of personal data for compliance with a legal obligation to which we are subject under any applicable EU law or under any applicable law of a country in which the GDPR is applicable in whole or in part.

lit. d) Processing of personal data to protect the vital interests of the data subject or another natural person.

lit. f) Processing of personal data to protect the legitimate interests of us or third parties, unless the fundamental freedoms and rights and interests of the data subject prevail.

Legitimate interests are, in particular, our business interest in being able to provide our

website, information security, the enforcement of our own legal claims and compliance with Swiss law.

We process personal data for the duration required for the respective purpose or purposes. In the case of longer-term retention obligations due to legal and other obligations to which we are subject, we restrict processing accordingly.

Contacting us

You can send us an e-mail to contact us. If you wish, you can use an e-mail address that does not allow any conclusions to be drawn about your person.

We would like to point out that data transmission by e-mail can have security gaps. Complete protection of data against access by third parties is not possible.

Contact form

If you send us a message via the contact form, we store the data you provide (e.g. your e-mail address, possibly your name and telephone number) in order to answer your questions. We will not pass on this data without your consent.

Your rights to information, deletion, blocking

You have the right to free information about your stored personal data, its origin and recipients and the purpose of data processing as well as the right to correct, block or delete this data at any time. You can contact us at any time at the address given in the legal notice if you have further questions on the subject of personal data.

Privacy policy for objection to advertising emails

We hereby object to the use of contact data published as part of our obligation to provide a legal notice for the purpose of sending unsolicited advertising and information material. The operators of the website expressly reserve the right to take legal action in the event of the unsolicited sending of advertising information, such as spam e-mails.

Cookies

In addition to the data mentioned in the section "Collection and storage of personal data when accessing the website", so-called cookies are stored on your end device (laptop, tablet, smartphone, etc.) when you use our website. These are small text files that are stored on your hard disk and assigned to the browser you are using; cookies provide the

entity that sets the cookie with certain information. Cookies are used to make our website more user-friendly and effective. Cookies do not give us direct knowledge of your identity. Cookies cannot execute programs or transfer viruses to your computer.

Our website only uses session cookies. These store a so-called session ID, with which various requests from your browser can be assigned to the session. Session cookies can be used to recognize that you have already visited individual pages of our website. The session data is automatically deleted when you leave our site or close your browser. You can also delete the cookies in your browser's security settings at any time.

You can also visit our website without cookies. To do this, you must configure your browser settings so that cookies are not accepted. In this case, you may not be able to use all the functions of our website.
